International Value Composite: The International Value Composite invests in a portfolio of approximately 45 non-US companies. Positions are selected using an active, bottom-up approach from an international universe of value stocks ranging from small cap to large cap. ROE, Price to Tangible Book, Cash Flow Yield, Enterprise Value to Sales, and other internal research are all utilized to identify value opportunities. Key material risks for this strategy include the risks that stock prices will decline and that the composite will underperform its benchmark. The International Value composite is compared against the iShares MSCI EAFE ETF (EFA). The International Value composite has a minimum of \$300,000. The International Value composite was created in January 2025 and incepted on December 1, 2017.

The currency used to express performance is USD. Gross-of-fee returns are reduced by trading costs. Net-of-fee returns are calculated using a model fee of 1%. The model fee is the highest investment management fee that may be charged for this composite. The annual model management fee is applied on a monthly basis, by deducting 1/12th of the model fee from the monthly gross returns. Composite dispersion is measured by the asset-weighted standard deviation of annual gross returns of those portfolios included in the composite for the full year. The 3-year annualized standard deviation measures the variability of the composite gross returns and benchmark returns over the preceding 36-month period. The investment management fee for the composite is 1.00%. Actual investment advisory fees incurred by clients are negotiable and may vary.
